

Wheelchair Rugby Development Clinic - Bali, Indonesia June 9 to 13, 2016

The International Wheelchair Rugby Federation, with the support of the Agitos Foundation, will be hosting a wheelchair rugby clinic in Bali, Indonesia, from June 9 to 13, 2016.

This is an introductory clinic for athletes, coaches, referees, classifiers, and volunteers. No knowledge or experience of wheelchair rugby is required to participate.

The aim of the clinic is to introduce new participants to the sport and give them knowledge and information to assist them in developing wheelchair rugby programs in their home countries. The clinic trainers are internationally experienced athletes, coaches, and officials who are recognized experts in their area of this sport. There will be plenty of discussion and practical advice.

This clinic will be a great opportunity for athletes, officials, and volunteers from your country to learn more about this exciting and fast-growing Paralympic sport.

Training sessions will include information on the rules of Wheelchair Rugby; athlete profiles and classification; referees and officiating; coaching wheelchair rugby; and playing wheelchair rugby. The focus will be on practical knowledge and skills, combining classroom training with on-court practice for all participants.
